Association Rules and Bye-aws

1. Membership cards and rod licence must be carried at all times, and are to be shown when requested.
2. No Keepnets (Without the committees permission)
3. No Live Baiting
4. Membership tickets are for the named member only,
All guests must have a day ticket and valid licence.
5. No Blood worm or Joker
6. Barbless hooks only
7. Close all gates at Llyn Tacan (Beware of the horses)
8. Take your litter home
9. NO fires on alny club waters
10. Only park in authorised areas, do not block access to other users
11. Do not ship poles back across the public pathway at Breakwater Park
12. No night fishing at Breakwater Park
13. Maximum 2 Rods—**DO NOT leave rods unattended**

On Llyn Tacan the committee recommend that all PIKE be humanly culled.

Competition Rules

(Contact the Competition Secretary for details on away venue rules)

- a. Only the Competition Secretary or their appointed deputy will organise the pegging and draw at each match.
- b. Disability Pegs:- The 1st 3 pegs closest to the car park will be deemed as disability pegs at each match(if Needed), anyone requiring disability pegs must inform the match secretary before the draw. All decisions will be at the discretion of the Competition Secretary.
- c. A **Minimum of Four Members** must take part in any match for it to count towards an overall league result. The individual match winner shall receive 25 2nd 24 -, if any individuals weights are tied they received the same number of points. If anyone fails to weigh in they will receive zero points..
- d. All competitors are responsible for their full share of any pegging / venue costs, optional pools available on the day.
- e. **Weighing in at matches.** Will consist of a 3 man team including the Competition Secretary (or his appointed deputy) who will be responsible for all the paperwork and supervision of the weigh-in, plus matchmen from pegs 1 & 2 if able bodied, if not to continue down the line i.e. pegs 3 or 4 .
- f. Only one rod or pole to be used at a time. Only 1 Hook to be used at a time. Ledgering is allowed on all home venues **(away venues where local bye-laws/ rules allow).**
- g. On still water venues, the area of a peg will be classed as 50% of the distance between that and the next occupied pegs to the left & right and half the distance across the lake. On running water It shall be classed as up to 1 yard from the next occupied downstream peg.
- h. Plumbing of the depth is allowed prior to the start of a match; no pre-baiting is allowed prior to the all-in.
- i. A First Aid kit and safety rope must be carried on all Senior / Junior Matches /Coaching events. The first Aid Kit is to be held on Peg-1, and a safety rope is to be held on the first , middle and end peg.
- j. The competition secretary on the day decision is final regarding all competition matters; The secretary must be notified in writing of any disputed decision within 7 days of the match. The committee's decision will be deemed final.
